DORSET DRAMA LEAGUE

The League was founded in 1937 and its role was to continue and develop the work started by the Drama Section of the Rural Community Council.

Affiliated to the British Drama League, it undertook to run a Community Festival as 'Stage One' of the ALL ENGLAND THEATRE FESTIVAL, a nationwide elimination contest for oneact plays.

The Festival exists to provide for amateurs an opportunity to measure the standard of their work and to learn how to improve it; of assessing the work of other Companies and hearing constructive criticism of an Adjudicator. It seeks to encourage in amateurs originality and adventure in the assistance of an experienced Adjudicator in assessing and appreciating the work they see on the stage.


