About Wimborne Drama Club . . .

in 1928 a group of enthusiasts staged a play in the local Women's Institute Hall: the Wimborne Drama Club was born.

For 10 years the Club went from strength to strength, but the War and the demolition of the W.I. Hall temporarily halted the Club's progress.

A move was made to Church House which was to be the setting for a regular succession of plays for many years, performed twice a year before a small but growing audience.

In 1968 the Club decided to widen its horizons: Wimborne had grown considerably; Church House had a limited seating capacity; the stage was inadequate and offered little scope for more adventurous productions. A larger hall and a professionally equipped stage were sought; both these were offered at the Wimborne Modern School.

We know that new ideas keep a club alive; new ideas come from new members. Why don't you join us? Why not come to our meetings in the Grammar School Annexe at 8 p.m. on the last Thursday of every month?

About the Play . .

How to project a charade? It is so difficult not to make it seem nonsense. There must be a firm base to build on and this we have in Christopher Fry's excellent translation of Anoulin's play. "L'invitation ou' château".

The problems of producing a foreign play, particularly a French one, are not only of translation of words but also of style. The traditions of the Commedia dell' Arte are almost unknown in this country, so a style must be created which an English audience will find acceptable.

In this charade, I hope each character will become recognisable either as we ourselves are, as we should like to be or, perhaps, as others see us.
