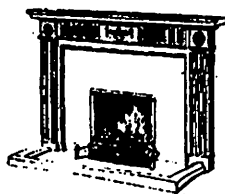

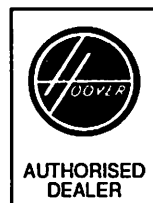

BRYAN TABRAH. Bryan has acted with several companies in both England and Germany. He is a former member of Bridlington Theatre Workshop, where he acted in many productions, as well as directing 'Zoo Story', 'Absent Friends' and 'Abigail's Party'.

ADAM MacRAE. Adam is a tenth year student at Queen Elizabeth School, where he is currently working towards, amongst others, a GCSE in Drama. He first trod the boards at the tender age of seven in the Stourport Community production of 'Spike'. Since then he has appeared in many plays including Allenbourn Middle School's production of 'Dazzle', and three A.C.E. plays. Last year he played the role of Lysander in the Dream Theatre Company's production of 'A Midsummer Nights Dream' at Gaunts House. He is enjoying working with a new group, and looks forward to more productions with them.
